On behalf of Animal Wellness Action (AWA), a national policy and political organization dedicated to advancing legal protections for animals, we are pleased to endorse your re-election campaign to the U.S. Congress. Your strong advocacy and leadership on numerous animal welfare issues have earned our full support.

During the 118th Congress, you have been a steadfast champion for animal welfare. Your cosponsorship of critical bills such as the FIGHT Act and PAST Act demonstrates your deep commitment to ensuring the protection of animals from harm and exploitation. We look forward to continuing our collaboration with you on these and other key legislative efforts.

We also want to commend you for introducing the Accountability in Foreign Animal Research (AFAR) Act. This important legislation will help prevent U.S. tax dollars from being used to conduct or support research on vertebrate animals in countries designated as foreign adversaries, including China, Russia, Iran, North Korea, Cuba, and the Maduro regime of Venezuela.

Additionally, AWA wants to commend your strong leadership in serving as the leading sponsor of the bi-partisan Veterans for Mustangs Act (VMA). This measure is designed to help protect existing populations of wild horses and burros on federal lands, which in turn can be beneficial by reducing the need for inhumane helicopter roundups as wildlife management tools. Furthermore, this proposal would give veterans with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) an opportunity to heal from the injuries they have incurred during combat. This bill is an excellent policy proposal, and AWA is pleased to work hand-in-hand with you toward its passage and enactment.

Respect for American democracy and the humane treatment of animals are fundamental values that must be upheld. The way we treat animals, both individually and as a nation, reflects our society's moral compass.
